

Rules for granting individual curriculum plans

According to § 17 of the Regulations of full-time and part-time higher education studies at Gdańsk University of Technology, a student can study according to an individual study/curriculum plan, including an individualized education plan or an individualized study plan, according to the established by the Dean.

Rules for granting an individualized study plan at the Faculty of Management and Economics

1. An individualized study plan gives the student the right to agree with the lecturer on individual dates and forms of fulfilling the obligations resulting from the study plan, as well as the detailed rules for receiving credit for a given subject. After receiving the decision on the individualized study plan, the student is obliged to determine the rules of completing subjects in a given semester within the first two weeks after the start of classes in a given semester. If no effort is made to establish special arrangements for receiving credit, the lecturer will grade the student based on the rules applicable to all students.
2. The dean may grant permission for students to study according to an individualized study plan for reasons outlined in §17, section 7 of the Regulations of full-time and part-time higher education studies at Gdańsk University of Technology.
3. An individualized study plan may be granted to a pregnant student or a student who is a parent.
4. The individualized curriculum request (addressed to the vice dean), along with the corresponding certificates, must be submitted to the dean's office prior to the start of the semester in which the individualized curriculum is to take effect.

Rules for granting an individualized education plan at the Faculty of Management and Economics

1. An individualized education plan ensures that content is selected according to the student's academic interests and in accordance with the learning outcomes established for a given major.
2. In the case of studying according to an individualized education plan, it is necessary to collaborate with a research supervisor who will be responsible for determining the education program for the student. A research supervisor can be an employee of the Faculty of Management and Economics employed at least as a university professor.
3. The condition for obtaining an individualized education plan is:
 - completion of previous semesters without credit points debt,
 - outstanding academic performance,
 - documentation of academic achievements or participation in research and development teams at the university,
 - implementation of a part of study program at another university,
 - implementation of studies as part of an individual interdisciplinary study program, including at least two fields of study, allowing the student to obtain a diploma in more than one field of study.
4. An application for an individualized education plan (addressed to the appropriate vice- dean), along with the appropriate certificates, must be submitted to the dean's office prior to the beginning of the semester in which the individualized education plan will take effect. The request must be accompanied by:

- a proposal for an individualized education plan, taking into account the learning outcomes for a given field of study,
- consent of the research supervisor designated by the student for the coordination of the individualized education plan.

The rules are effective as of 1 May 2021.
