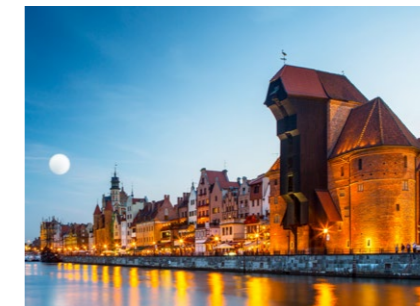

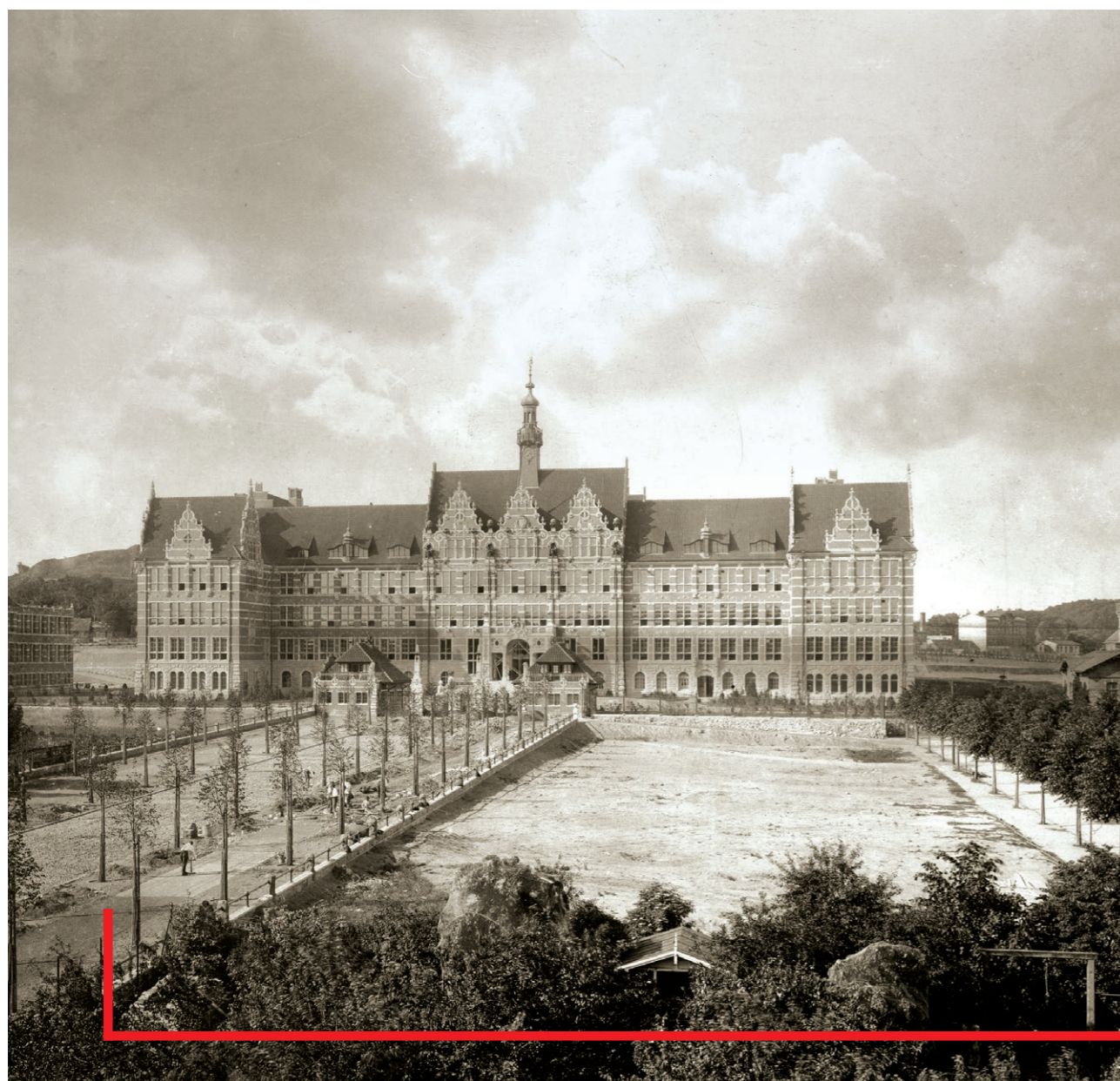

- GUT was classified as one of the 10 most beautiful universities in Europe according to the Times Higher Education University Rankings.

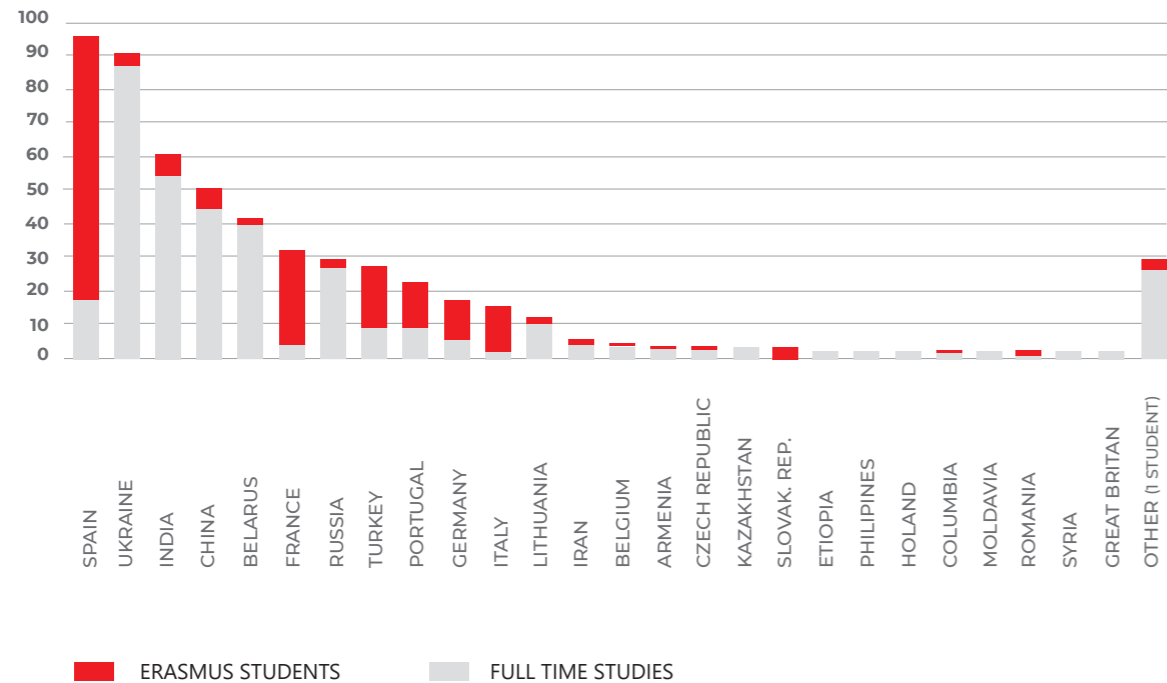

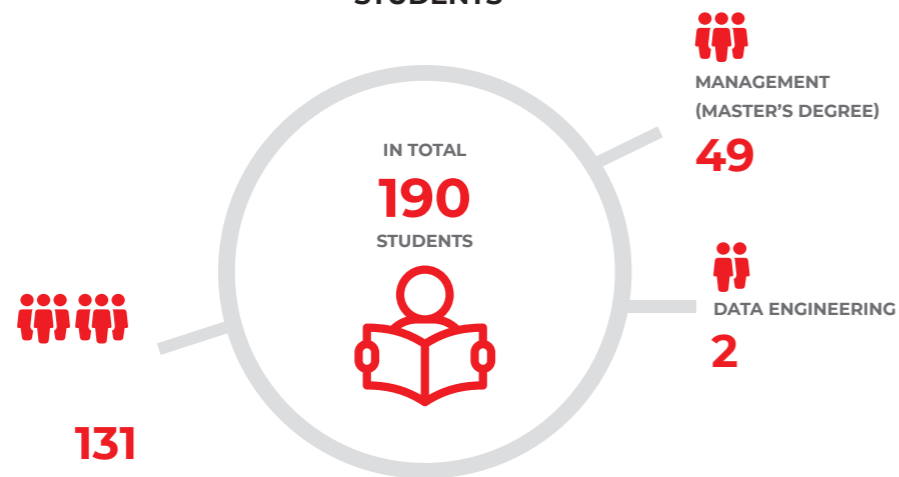

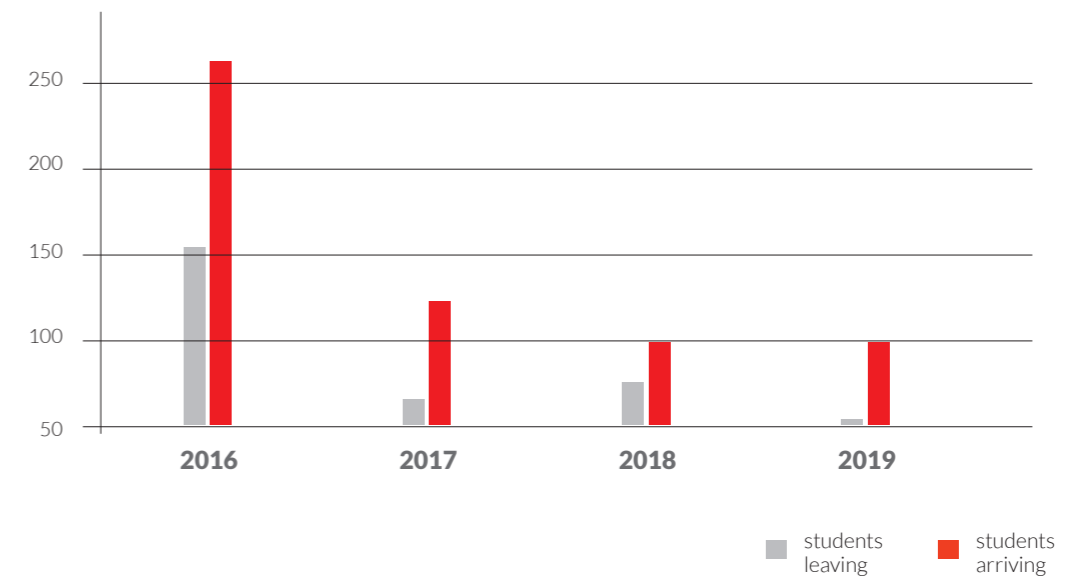

WHAT TO CHOOSE FROM?

01

INTERNATIONAL STAFF

In all programmes, classes are conducted fully in English by lecturers from the Gdańsk University of Technology and visiting professors from abroad (almost half of the staff), and provide students with the opportunity to take advantage of their unique experience and knowledge.

02

DOUBLE-DEGREE PROGRAMMES

Some of the courses take part in a double-degree program with universities in Italy and France. As a student, you can spend one academic year at a partner university and then officially obtain the master degree of two universities.

03

INTERNATIONAL AND NATIONAL EXCHANGE PROGRAMMES

You can choose to study in a variety of European countries within the Erasmus + programme (80 universities to choose from), to study in China within ECTS credit transfer programs (5 universities available) or study for a semester or two in another Polish city (over 20 universities to choose from).

BiM is a comprehensive, practice-relevant three-year degree. It is unique in Poland and spans across all spheres of business and management. It provides knowledge that helps to build comprehensive managerial competences. Professionally qualified managers are the key drivers of trade, commerce and public service, making decisions to help shape the world around them. What kind of qualities should they have? First of all, they should be knowledgeable about the contemporary economy and should be able to put this knowledge into use when managing companies. They should also be good organizers. Good managers should be creative, responsible, communicative and entrepreneurial. That is why BiM is a place for people who are full of initiative and original ideas, outgoing and who can communicate in foreign languages (also in Polish due to the Polish language courses for foreigners). BiM is designed to give you the knowledge, confidence and choices you need to establish a rewarding and exciting career in a wide variety of settings.

DATA ENGINEERING // ENGINEER DEGREE

Duration: 3.5 years (7 semesters)

Language: English

ECTS points: 213

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

Making important decisions is always based on collecting and analysing huge amounts of information. Data engineering helps achieve this goal by combining the experience and expertise of two areas: information technology and management. Students of this field of study will learn how to deal with large amounts of data from different sources and how to interpret them. All this is based on computer programmes and algorithms, and knowledge of mathematics, statistics and economics. Due to the significant number of practical classes, students can be sure that after graduation they will not only be theoreticians, but experts prepared to work in the business environment.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Secondary school leaving certificate and very good knowledge of English. Very good knowledge of informatics or physics.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

Both IT departments of companies where IT expertise can be utilized for the strategic objectives of the business, and economic departments where you can use your knowledge to identify the economic needs of a company liaising with the teams developing project planning tools and top management of companies business in its widest sense – banking, finance, marketing.

Master in Economic Analysis offers candidates in-depth knowledge in the field of macro- and microeconomics, finance and accounting, and provides an expanded range of quantitative methods making it possible to conduct effective analyses in areas which are the basis for decision-making, both in corporations and specialized financial institutions. Analyses are supported with computer software. This programme, delivered in English, will broaden your knowledge and skills in macroeconomics and will help you to understand economic growth and development issues in the globalization era.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Arts (Law, Economics, Management). Very good knowledge of English.

CAREER OPPORTUNITIES

3 IMPORTANT FACTS:

01 Most of the courses are taught by highly qualified international staff from: Université de Lyon, Università Politecnica delle Marche, University of Naples, University of Florence and Centre for European Policy Studies.

02 Students have the opportunity to obtain double degrees with the Università Politecnica delle Marche or University of Florence in Italy. You can spend one or two semesters there and do student's apprenticeship, and then officially obtain the master degree of both (Polish and Italian) universities.

03 Students of Economic Analytics can choose the Eurostat-certified path that will develop their skills in statistical and econometric analysis using computer-assisted statistics (R, Stata, Statistica, QGIS, GeoDa), research methodology and descriptive statistics.

**PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION**

The objective of this new Master's programme in International Management is to develop future professionals capable of developing resourceful and innovative skills, and able to pursue successful opportunities in the dynamic international environment. This Master's in International Management offers an opportunity to expand your experience by deepening your knowledge in finance, human resources, operations, and marketing, among other strategic areas, all presented in an international context. International management knowledge and skills are advanced through academically rigorous courses and various interactive teaching methods.

Master in International Management as the only one in Poland received the international AMBA accreditation for the years 2018-2023, acknowledging a high standard of quality of studies. Moreover this course received the "excellent" accreditation evaluation, awarded by the Polish Accreditation Committee.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Bachelor of Science, Bachelor of Arts (Law, Economics, Management).

International Management graduates receive the highest salary compared to other management graduates in the field of economic sciences (according to Polish Graduate tracking system 2020). FME Alumni have the lowest risk to become unemployed after graduation.

INTERNATIONAL MBA IN STRATEGY, PROGRAMME AND PROJECT MANAGEMENT // POSTGRADUATE DEGREE – MASTER IN BUSINESS ADMINISTRATION

Degree to be obtained: postgraduate - Master in Business Administration

Duration: 2 years (4 semesters)

**PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION**

The international MBA program run at the Faculty of Management and Economics at GUT is a prestigious course (not a Master degree) that maintains the highest quality of professional education. This is demonstrated by the high positions in the rankings and the AMBA accreditation (only five Polish programs have it). As the only program from Poland, it was classified in the QS 2019 Ranking, ranked in the top nineteen Executive MBAs in the world and 10th in Europe in the Executive Profile category.

The main objectives of the programme are to promote:

- the development of participants' leadership, managerial and entrepreneurial competencies
- to strengthen their expertise in strategy, strategy implementation
- the management of complex situations through programme and project management approaches.

Knowledge is transferred during cyclical, weekend classes and foreign study trips, such as Barcelona Inspirational Safari.

Because the MBA is based on a dynamic framework, students may focus and specialize on a range of diverse competencies according to their interests and particular needs.

The framework of the programme is based on four key pillars:

1. Strategic Thinking
2. Operational Excellence
3. Foundations
4. People Management and Self Development

The teaching staff consists of scientists who are leaders in their scientific areas of management and economics and practitioners with great achievements in the field of entrepreneurship, innovation and business development.

The MBA program is not only professional knowledge but also valuable networking with absolute previous versions.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

The International MBA Program is targeted at management with a minimum of three years of managerial experience (after university degree completion). Obligatory is a university degree - a bachelor's or a master's, fluency in English. An international applicant from non-EU countries is required to hold a visa and a resident's card

MBA participants are senior managers, managers with extensive experience (15 years on average), Corporate Executives, SME Management, Entrepreneurs.

AGILE, DEVOPS AND LEAN IT IN VUCA WORLD // POSTGRADUATE DEGREE

Degree to be obtained: GUT certificate

Duration: 1 year (2 semesters)

Language: English

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION

The aim of the studies is to prepare participants to conduct a comprehensive transformation towards the agility of the organization in which they work. This transformation will be done by implementing an agile approach for ongoing initiatives. It also applies to large initiatives, where SCRUM approach is not enough but scaled solutions like Scaled Agile Framework (SAFe) are needed. Participants will also learn how to shorten time to market for IT solutions that are developed in their companies and how to constantly deliver the value.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

Undergraduate degree (bachelor or engineer) diploma.

ADMISSION PROCESS & ACCOMMODATION

- HOW TO APPLY, WHERE TO SLEEP?



RECRUITMENT

New incoming students take part in an Orientation Week. Therefore, we highly recommend coming to Gdańsk at least one week before the semester starting date.

RECRUITMENT PROCEDURE IN 3 STEPS:

- 1st step: apply on www.rekrutacja.pg.edu.pl between May and July. Upload entry documents (scans) and pay an application fee of PLN 85.
Important: Admission process usually takes 2-3 weeks, but please note that visa procedures might take even 3 months, please familiarize yourself with Polish visa application process.
- 2nd step: positive assessment will generate an Offer Letter to you: prepare the rest of the required documents and pay first semester tuition fee.
- 3rd step: Confirmation Letter will be issued. On its basis you will apply for a Polish visa. Take along the originals of all documents required before to Gdańsk.

WHAT LEVEL OF ENGLISH IS NEEDED?

- In the admission process, you have to provide an International English Certificate confirming English proficiency at least at the B2 level or a Statement issued by a university confirming English as the medium of instruction during the previous study cycle.

ACCOMMODATION

- At GUT's Campus you can find 12 dormitories which offer 3,000 places. Prices: €80 - 120 per bed.
- Our University guarantees accommodation for international students. No additional application for accommodation is required for new arrivals. However, it will be necessary to apply for accommodation for the second academic year.



- You can also rent a room in Gdańsk (single room ≈ €250). Our university is located almost in the centre of Gdańsk, regardless of which district you intend to live in, you will be able to quickly reach our Faculty by tram, bus or train.

The Tri-City offers many attractions, not only for tourists, but also it's a place where large events take place



01 OPEN'ER FESTIVAL

A very famous music festival taking place in Gdynia since 2003 at the turn of June and July. The first edition of the festival was held in Warsaw in 2002 as the Open Air Festival. The festival hosted artists and bands such as Depeche Mode, Bruno Mars, Florence and the Machine, Red Hot Chili Peppers, Pharrell Williams, Lana Del Rey, Swedish House Mafia etc. On average, over 120,000 people have fun during the festival.

02 SOPOT FESTIVAL

An international music festival taking place in Sopot since 1961. Over the years this festival has strengthened its position on the list of the most important music events, as a window to the world, successfully competing with the Eurovision Festival.



03 POLISH FILM FESTIVAL IN GDYNIA

One of the oldest film events in Europe which promotes Polish cinematography on such a wide scale. It exists since 1974 and each year, the audience can familiarize themselves with the most recent Polish productions. The most interesting Polish films, premieres, debuts and international film festivals' prize-winners compete over the Golden and Silver Lions. The Festival is the most important Polish film event, holding the status of a national film festival.

04 THE GREAT ORCHESTRA OF CHRISTMAS

It is a public benefit organization aiming to support and improve medical care in public hospitals nationwide. It is the most known in Poland due to the "Grand Finale" – annual, held in the whole Poland, 1-day festival full of concerts, charity auctions, fireworks and laser shows and, of course, collecting donations to collection cans for a noble purpose - for Polish hospitals. Every year donations come from all over the world, every year more and more, reaching a record of PLN 186 million in 2019.

TOP 5 SECRET PLACES



01 // WISŁOUJŚCIE FORTRESS

- is a historic fortress located in Gdańsk by the Martwa Wisła river, by an old estuary of the Vistula river, flowing into the Bay of Gdańsk. It is a unique example of a relatively well-preserved port defense structure from the first half of the 17th century. In the 19th century, the Prussians housed a prison in the dungeons of the Tower. You can see there many artifacts connected with the unique history of this fortification. It is possible to visit the fortress with a guide by a small fee.



02 // TORPEDO STATION IN GDYNIA

- Torpedo Station is the Polish common name of the central facility of German torpedo research centres, built in occupied Poland during World War II. This building can be admired while walking along the beach in Babie Doły - a district of Gdynia. Currently, it is only an exercise area for divers, not suitable for sightseeing. There is also a cliff nearby from which you can admire the Bay of Gdańsk.



03 // PACHOLEK HILL

- It is located on the edge of the Tricity Landscape Park, in the Gdańsk Oliwa district. At the top of the hill, there is an observation tower (15 meters of high), from where we can admire the panorama of the Tri-City.

04 // THE OBSERVATION TOWER IN KOLIBKI

- an observation tower located at Spółdzielcza street in Orłowo- Gdynia's district, in the area of Kolibki. This tower is 50 meters high. It is available for visitors for free, from April 1 to October 31. You can admire the amazing view of the Gdańsk Bay from the side of Gdynia as well as from the side of the forests of the Tri-City Landscape Park.



05 // THE SOBIESZEWO ISLAND

- a seaside district of Gdańsk located 15 km from the city centre, where you can spend time actively. The island has a lot of walking and cycling paths, beautiful sandy beaches and forests where you can observe many species of birds and animals such as seals that can be seen basking in the sun.

// PARTIES

- If you are looking for a good place to have fun, both the centre of Sopot and Gdańsk offer many clubs and events. In Sopot, most clubs are located along Bohaterów Monte Cassino Street, which is the main street of the city (promenade, also commonly known as "Monciak"). In Gdańsk, most clubs are located in the Old Town area and Elektryków street ;)

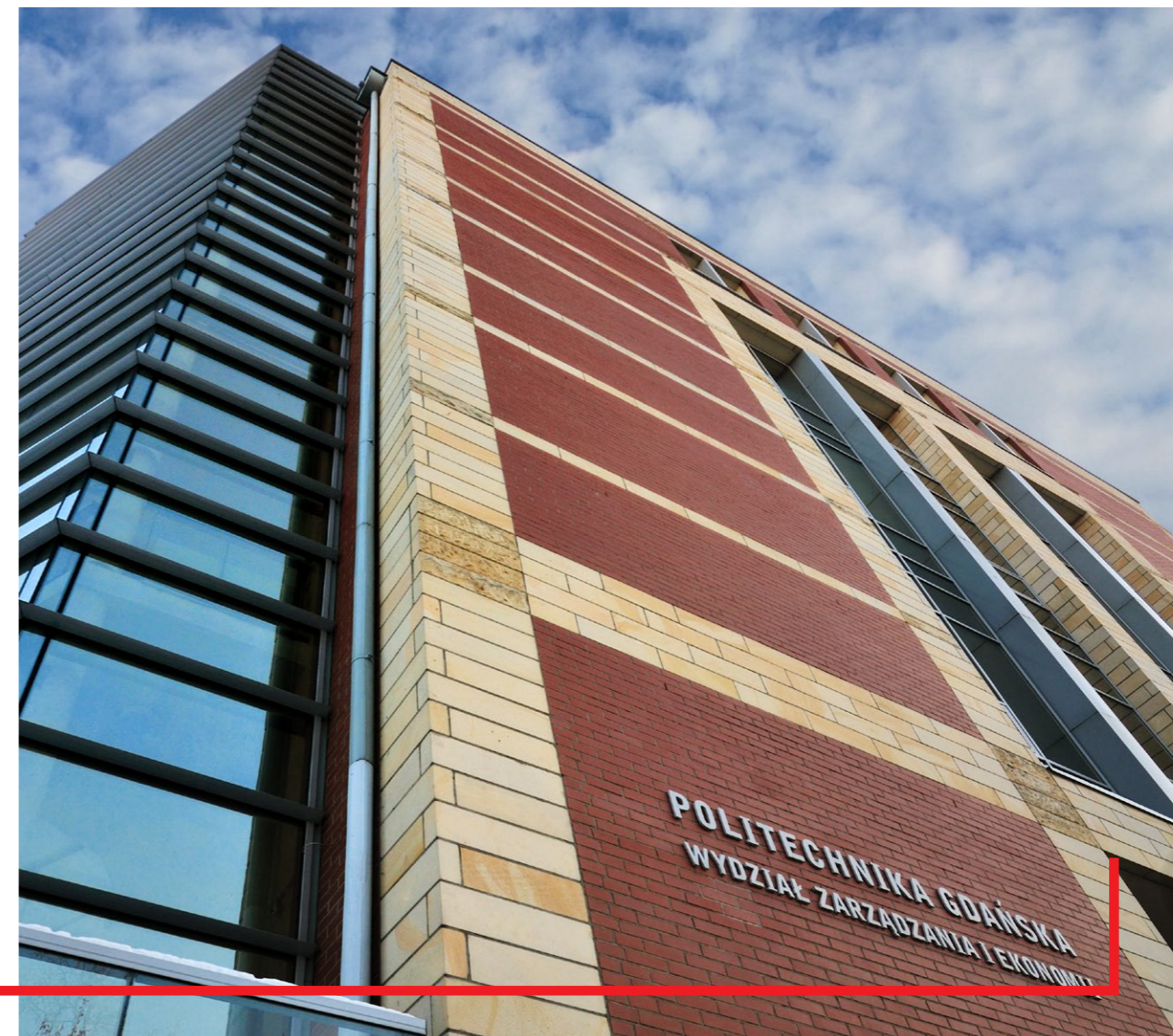
